For the commemoration of the mystery of the day the Missal foresees the blessing of candles with a procession or with a solemn entry. The faithful should gather in a lesser church or in another suitable place outside the church to which the procession is directed. They hold in their hands, candles which they light at the beginning of the rite. As the procession enters the church, the entrance song is sung, after which, omitting the usual opening rites, the Gloria is sung immediately and the collect of the day follows. The Mass then proceeds in the usual way. Masses of the dead are not permitted, with the exception of funeral Masses.

LENTEN SEASON

Time during the year is interrupted.

For Liturgical Hours, Volume of Breviary changes.

The season of Lent is a preparation for the celebration of Easter. The liturgy prepares the catechumens for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery by the various stages of Christian initiation; it also prepares the faithful, who recall their baptism and do penance in preparation for Easter (LY 27)

During Lent:

- a. *In all the Masses and Office, Alleluia, if found, is omitted.*
- b. *In the weekday office, the Invitatory antiphon, the Hymns for the Office of Readings, for Lauds and for Vespers, and the antiphon at the Middle Hours are taken from those prescribed for the season.*
- c. *In all Solemnities and Feasts, and also in special celebrations, 'Te Deum' and 'Gloria' are said.*
- d. *The nuptial blessing is to be always given in celebrating the Matrimony either in the mass or outside the mass. The spouses may, however, be advised to abstain from too much pomp.*

About the feast of the saints:

During the ferial days of Lent, Gen. Instructions on the Liturgy of Hours no. 239 are to be followed: If any one wishes to celebrate the office of a saint whose memoria occurs:

- i) *in the Office of Readings, after the patristic readings with its resp. from the Proper of the Season, should add the proper hagiographical reading with its resp. and conclude with the prayer of the saint.*
- ii) *after the concluding prayer at Lauds and Vespers he may add the ant. (ppr. or comm) and prayer of the saint.*

Ash Wednesday

1. *Day of fast and abstinence.*
2. *Ashes, made from the blessed palms or branches of the previous year are blessed and imposed after the Gospel and homily of the Mass. The Penitential rite is omitted.*
3. *Ashes can also be blessed without there being a Mass. But the Liturgy of the Word must precede just as the Mass, till the Gospel and the homily inclusive. In this latter case, the rite is closed with the prayer of the faithful.*

HOLY WEEK**Note for Holy Week**

1. *In Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, from his messianic entry into Jerusalem, until his blessed Passion and glorious Resurrection. With the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday begins the Easter Triduum, which includes Good Friday of the Lord's Passion and Holy Saturday, centres upon the Easter Vigil, and concludes with the vespers on Easter Sunday of the Lord's Resurrection.*
2. *The rites of the Holy Week, i.e., blessing of procession of palms, reposition of the Most Holy Sacrament after the Mass of the Lord's Supper, Liturgical service of Good Friday, of the Passion of the Lord and Easter Vigil, may be celebrated in all the churches, be it public and semi-public oratories. It is fitting, however, that in non-parochial churches and oratories they are*

celebrated only if they can be had worthily, i.e., with sufficient number of ministers capable of executing at least some parts, with singing and with sufficient attendance of the faithful. Otherwise it is fitting that such celebrations are performed only in parochial and other major churches. It is also expedient that regarding this, special norms are given by the competent ecclesiastical authority.

Note for Palm Sunday

1. *The memory of the Entry of the Lord into Jerusalem is to be celebrated at all the Masses of this Sunday. This is done with the procession or with the solemn entry before the principal Mass and with the simple entry before other Masses. The solemn entry, not the procession, may be repeated before other Masses celebrated with a large attendance of people.*
2. *After the procession or solemn entry, the sign of the cross and penitential rite, or sprinkling at the beginning of the Mass, are omitted, and immediately prayer of the assembly is said. The rest of the Mass proceeds as usual.*

Care must be taken that this celebration is not had only for private convenience, and it should not affect the participation in the evening Mass.*
6. *Priests who concelebrate at the Chrism Mass, or have otherwise celebrated for the benefit of the faithful, may again concelebrate at the evening Mass.*
7. *The faithful are to be admonished that, for a convenient time of the night, according to local circumstances, they should have the adoration before*

the Bl. Sacrament. But after midnight, this adoration is to be had without any solemnity.

8. *If the evening Mass is followed by the reposition of the Bl. Sacrament, then there should also be celebrated the liturgical action of Good Friday.*

Evening Prayer is not said by those who assist at the Evening Mass.
